The gills are firmly attached to the stem, clay-colored or brown, moderately close. The stem is stuffed or nearly hollow, slender, rigid, squamulose, pallid, quite short. The spores are ferruginous-brown, elliptical, 7x3. 51. I have found this species quite frequently where an old stump had been burned out. It is gregarious. I have only found it from September to November...
